



Sri Lanka reopens for tourists after 10 months

The Sri Lanka Tourism Promotion Bureau has set up "Safe and Secure" bubbles, mandating predeparture and post-arrival PCR tests for tourists, restricting stay to designated Safe and Secure' certified, Level 1 hotel and beach resorts, and allowing access to select tourist spots only to limit visitors from mixing with the local community. Full operations have resumed at the island's two international airports, for commercial flights.
